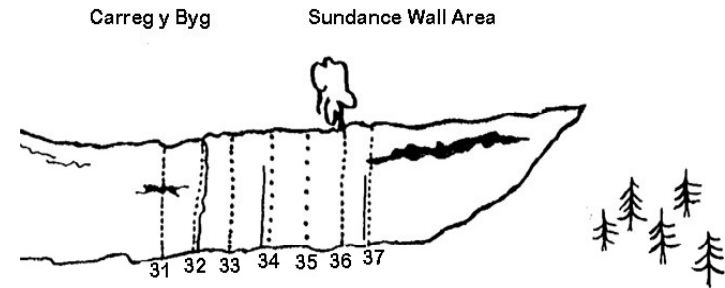

To the right, **Perkins Route**, Very Difficult, climbs the slabby corner via the earth mound. This occasionally provides an ice route during the winter. **Stagger**, Hard Severe 4A, climbs the dirty staggered crack between *Perkins Route* and *Crystal Crack*.



THE SUNDANCE WALL AREA

The steep, clean wall some 15 yards right of *Perkins Route* offers a concentration of good routes. The wall contains an obvious straight crack, *Crystal Crack*.

31. **Barkers Route** HVS 5B
The steep wall 6ft to the left of *Crystal Crack* provides a difficult problem via a large pocket.
32. **Crystal Crack** VS 4B **
The crack provides one of the most pleasant routes in the quarry. Steep and well protected climbing but some care is required on the finishing moves.
33. **Scoop Route** HVS 5A *
Good climbing. The wall just right of *Crystal Crack* passing a large thread. Finish direct.
34. **Sundance Wall** HVS 5A **
A delightful route on impeccable rock. Climb the short finger crack before finishing direct or by moving left to join *Scoop Route*.
